- The project should have a lion character that can move around the screen.
- Incorporate music or sound effects commonly associated with the lion dance.
- Implement user interaction, such as pressing a key or clicking the mouse, to trigger the lion dance movements.
- Include visual elements like firecrackers or lanterns to add to the festive atmosphere.
- Bonus points for adding a storyline or educational facts about Chinese New Year.
