

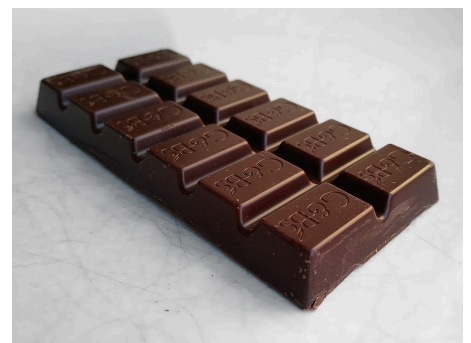
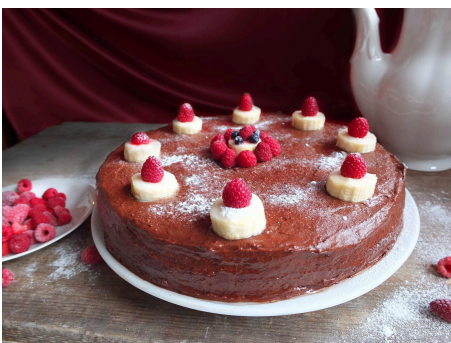
There are all sorts of wonderful ways we can incorporate chocolate (or whatever your favourite food is!) into a Scratch project. Here are some ideas, but feel free to come up with your own...

1. Can you create an animation that:

- Tell us about your favourite foods or favourite chocolate bar?
- Shows us how your favourite food is made, this could be how you would make a meal by combining ingredients, or how you imagine a chocolate bar is made in a factory?
- Imagine different foods come to life (a bit like Toy Story!!) What personality does each food have, and how to they interact with each other?
- A dancing food animation a bit like [this sensory video](#) for very young kids

2. Or could you make a game?

- A game where you get to explore a food factory - your sprite could be someone who works in the factory, or a chocolate bar going through all the different machines to get made?
- A cooking game, where you have to collect different ingredients around the stage and make a meal out of what you collect. You could use variables to count up how many ingredients you collect.
- A sorting game, where you make random foods appear on the screen, and you sort them into fruits, vegetables, deserts, meat, dairy and so on!
- A game where the characters are different foods that go on an adventure
